ROAD MILLAGE AT WORK

We have done many projects to improve our roads over the last ten years using money from the voted road millage. While our roads are far from perfect they are much better than they would have been without the voted road millage.

With the increased traffic using our roads it would be difficult to maintain the roads without this millage. The current millage expires at the end of 2011. The Township Board will likely request a renewal of the current millage to be used to ditch, regrade, apply dust control, reblacktop, and create some new hard surfacing over the next five years.
