TOWNSHIP NEWS

Recreation Passport Grant

Oceola Township has applied for a "Recreation Passport Grant" of \$45,000 dollars. Once approved, the grant with additional monies paid by the Township, will allow for a play structure for tots, paving the existing gravel parking area, and providing a paved ADA accessible area for walking and emergency vehicle accessibility to the rear fields.

We are also applying for an Enbridge Grant of \$25,000 to help build a pavilion by our hall.

Land Acquisition

The Township has purchased the ten acres on the north side of our site. The building previously used as a church will be used by the Recreation Authority. The garage will be used by the Fire Authority. As a Board we have discussed the various options for the back four acres which may become additional recreation fields. Additional parking is planned to be installed for the current recreation fields. We are considering selling the frontage on Latson Road for development and rerouting the entrance to flow through the Town Hall entrance.

M-59/Highland Road

M-59 is being resurfaced; road work has started and will continue through November.

CHEMUNG HILLS

The Township has concluded our settlement with Dupont for the trees that were lost on the Golf Course due to imprellis damage.



ROAD MILLAGE AT WORK



The paving project on Clyde Road is complete. In 2014 we will be working on one mile of Kellogg Road and are considering improving one-half mile of Fisher Road jointly with Howell Township. Our dust control work on the gravel roads continues with road millage dollars.

The paper recycling bin located in the south parking lot is for recycling newspapers, magazines, office papers, school papers, mail and catalogs. It is getting a lot of use. The bin is open twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week and is available for all residents.
