Recreation Passport Grant

We have re-applied for and are waiting to hear if we will receive the Recreation Passport Grant that we applied for with the State of Michigan. We are hopeful that we can start building the park amenities the grant will fund soon.

Enbridge Grant

We received a \$25,000 grant offered by Enbridge Pipeline Company. We will be adding paved trails to the Township Hall park.

Land Sales

We are selling land we acquired at tax sale. The result of those sales will leave our Township Bond accounts in a very strong financial position and will insure that there is not a drain on General Township funds. These sales will also enable us to repair more roads.

M-59/ Highland Road

MDOT will be adding a center turn lane to M-59 at Hacker Road during the 2014 construction season.

Chemung Hills

We continue to improve the golf course and banquet center and the use level is increasing.

Road Millage at Work

This year we are working with the County Road Commission to rebuild part of Argentine, Clyde, Kellogg and Golf Club roads along with the continuation of dust control on all our gravel roads. These improvements were paid for out of the Road Millage fund and the General fund.

There is a paper recycling bin located in the south parking lot at the Oceola Township Hall for recycling paper products, such as newspapers, magazines, office papers, school papers, mail and catalogs. The bin is open twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

Recycle Livingston

Recycle Livingston, the only non-profit recycling center serving the residents of Livingston County and committed to reducing the flow of solid waste to local landfills, would like your help. Only about 16% of solid waste materials are currently recycled in Michigan. To help increase that percentage Recycle Livingston provides accessible and affordable recycling for all County residents. Annual membership is just \$27 for a regular household and only \$22 for a senior household. Small businesses can join for \$87 a year. We also offer free memberships in exchange for volunteer hours to ensure all County residents, regardless of their economic situation, have access to recycling services. But many County residents still don't know we exist.
