This year's road maintenance program included resurfacing the blacktop portions of Golf Club Road between Grand River and Latson road. This was done in cooperation with Genoa Township, Livingston County Road Commission and Oceola Township. Next year we are cooperating with Hartland Township on the paving of Hacker Road and are looking into what can be done with the closed bridge on Eager Road, north of M59.

We are continuing to see vigorous building occurring in the areas of the Township which have sewer and water. Several builders have acquired available properties and are actively building. It will take 5 to 10 years for the current properties which are under construction to become built out.

Located at 170 Catrell Street is the only nonprofit recycling center serving the residents of Livingston County and committed to reducing the flow of solid waste to local landfills. Howell Area Parks & Recreation

Oceola Township is part of the Howell Area Parks and Recreation Authority (HAPRA), which allows all Oceola Township residents two (2) vehicle passes per residence to enter Howell City Park and the boat launch for free. Passes are available from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Passes can be picked up at the Bennett Recreation Center located at 925 West Grand River. For information, call 517-546-0693. Oceola Residents also receive a discounted price when paying to participate in various classes offered through HAPRA.
