The closed bridge on Eager Road north of M59 is now scheduled for reconstruction in 2018. In 2017 the Livingston County Road Commission is partnering with Oceola to begin the realignment of Eager Road at M59. This will allow MDOT to install a traffic light in 2018.

Oceola Park

Construction is in its final stages on Phase III of the Oceola Park Project. The north parking lot has been paved, and the completion of the walking paths is underway. Upon completion, we will have approximately one mile of walking/biking paths. Phases I and II have had much use since they were constructed, and the children are enjoying the play structure. The soccer fields are being used and managed by Howell Area Parks and Recreation Authority (HAPRA).

Howell Area Parks and Recreation

Oceola Township is part of the Howell Area Parks and Recreation Authority (HAPRA), which allows all Oceola Township residents two (2) vehicle passes per residence to enter Howell City Park & Boat Launch for free. Passes are required from May 1 through October 31 for free use of the facilities. Passes can be picked up at the Bennett Recreation Center located at 925 West Grand River Avenue between the hours of 9-6 Monday—Thursday and 9-5 on Friday.
